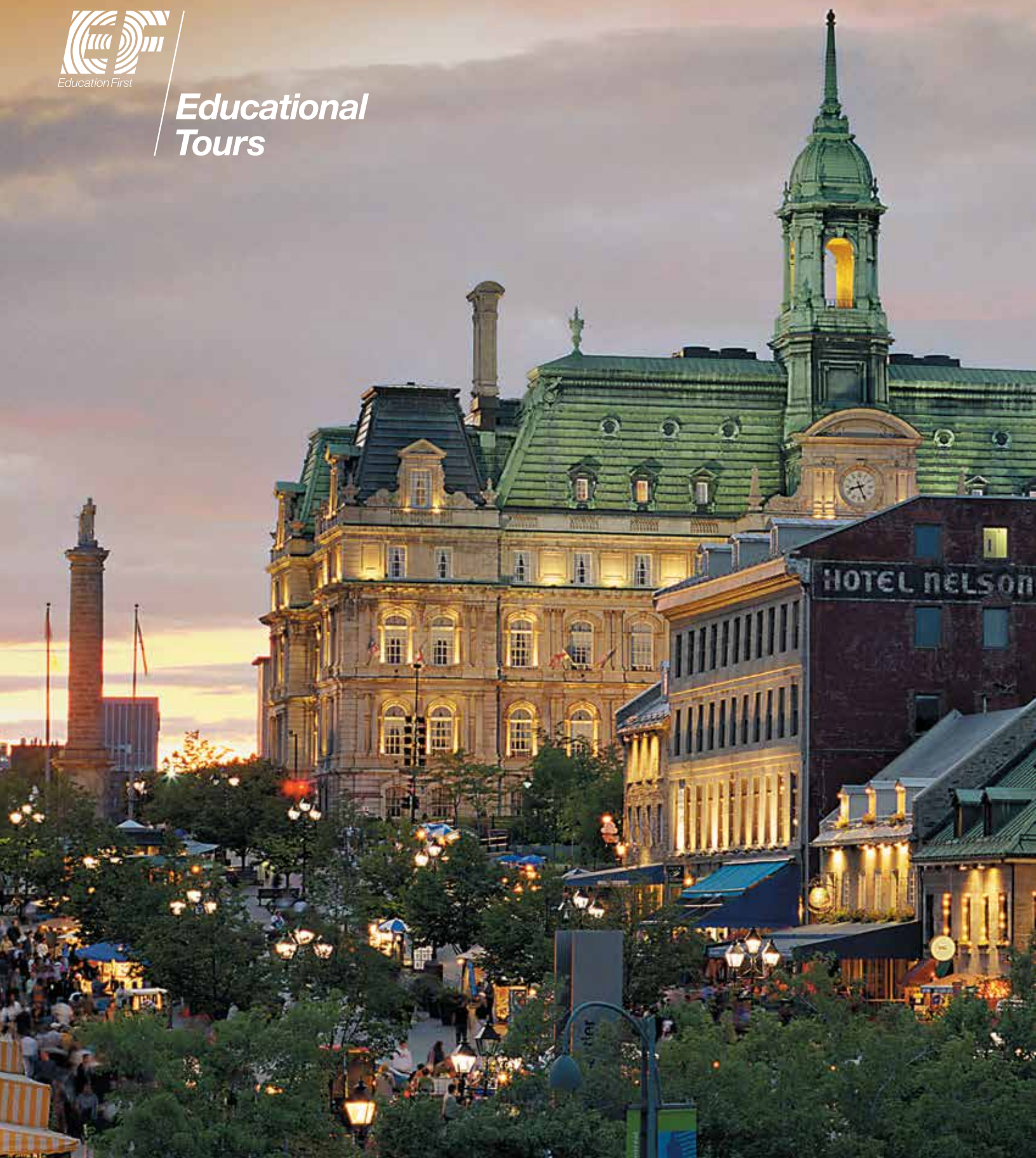

- Participate in an evening activity









DAY 6: OTTAWA

OLD MONTRÉAL

WALKING TOUR OF QUÉBEC CITY | Your Tour Director will lead you on a walk of the cliffs of Cap Diamant, first settled by French explorer Jacques Cartier. The cliffs are named for the iron pyrite and quartz crystals present at the site, which were originally mistaken for gold and precious stones, thus the name “Cape Diamond.” See the Citadelle, a fortress that dates back to 1820. Still garrisoned today, the fort is built in the shape of a four-pointed polygon in the historic neighbourhood of Québec City, which became a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1985. Then walk along the Promenade des Gouverneurs, a scenic walkway just below the Citadelle that provides wonderful views of the city and the St. Lawrence River.

OTTAWA | Walk the halls of power where decisions that shape our country are made, and walk through our history in some of the nation’s best museums. The imaginative Museum of History and the renowned Canadian War Museum bring Canada’s past into clear focus. Take a tour of the Parliament Buildings and ascend to the top of the 302-foot-tall Peace Tower. Parliament Hill and Rideau Canal are just some of the “must-sees” in Canada’s capital.

MONTRÉAL | It’s no wonder Montréal is a favourite of visitors from around the world—the cosmopolitan metropolis serves up a surprising menu of sights and delights. Enjoy the flavour of Europe in Old Montréal, a sampling of a tropical rainforest in the Biodôme and the lingering scent of history in elaborate buildings and cathedrals. Take in the dramatic views atop the Olympic Park Tower and Mount Royal, and feel the beat of *joie de vivre* on the streets.
