



In 1759, British General Wolfe defeated French troops under the command of General Montcalm. Though the British defeated the French, both generals were mortally wounded during the battle. With James Wolfe and Marquis de Montcalm as your guides, you'll participate in a re-enactment of the battle, with some students playing the role of French soldiers and others as British troops.
