Normandy Region

On June 6, 1944, Allied troops landed on the beaches of Normandy, launching the campaign that eventually liberated mainland Europe from the Nazis. Monuments, museums, bunkers and cemeteries are a living commemoration to the Battle of Normandy. Visit Beny-sur-Mer Canadian War Cemetery, the final resting place for brave Canadian soldiers that fought in this battle. Learn more about history at the Juno Beach Centre, which honours the war effort made by all Canadians, civilian and military alike, both at home and on the various fronts during the Second World War.

Ortona

Travel to Ortona – the small picturesque seaside town that became the site of fierce fighting between Canadian and German soldiers as part of the Italian campaign during the Second World War. You'll learn about how Canadian forces victoriously seized the town from the Germans in December 1943. To this day, the legendary Battle of Ortona remains one of Canada's greatest Second World War achievements. For those who fought the battle, Ortona was known as the "Italian Stalingrad". While both sides agreed the town was of little strategic value, the world transformed the battle into a matter of prestige between the Allies and the Germans.

Rome

History comes to life on your sightseeing tour of Rome. You'll walk through the Colosseum, the world's most famous arena. Its elaborate construction spanned two emperors – building began under the rule of Vespasian and was completed under the rule of Titus. Here, you can almost hear the stamping feet of the crowds gathered for gladiatorial combat. Nearby, the ruins of the Roman Forum mark the former heart of the Roman Empire, where Julius Caesar gave many of his great political speeches. Before you say *arrivederci*, toss a coin into the Trevi Fountain to ensure a return trip to the Eternal City.
