## What you'll experience on your tour

#### Day 1: Fly to Vietnam

#### Day 2: Hô Chi Minh City

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Hô Chi Minh City, which is still commonly referred to as Saigon, the name it held before South Vietnam fell to communism. During your stay, explore the vast network of Chu Chi Tunnels, vestiges of the Vietnam War and where you'll learn about the Viet Cong's art of warfare. Visit the Reunification Palace where power was officially transferred to the Communist Party in 1975. See the War Remnants Museum, which opened in 1975 and provides an interesting perspective on the United States' involvement in the Vietnam War. For a unique shopping experience, glide through a floating market on a traditional Asian longboat, docking alongside vendors to strike a bargain.

#### Day 3: Hô Chi Minh City

- Take an expertly guided Cù Chi Tunnels tour.
- Take an excursion to Ben Duoc: See the tunnel system of the Viet Cong.
- Visit the Reunification Palace.
- Visit the War Remnants Museum.

#### Day 4: Hô Chi Minh City

- Take an excursion to the village of Cái Bè.
- Visit a floating market.

#### Day 5: Hô Chi Minh City | Siem Reap

- Fly to Siem Reap, whose name means "Victory over the Thais" (in reference to the Khmer kingdom's victory in the 16th century). It's also the gateway to the ruins of Angkor Wat. While here, you'll explore massive temples dating back to the 12th century and learn about this ancient civilization, which, at its height, was home to more than 1 million people. Visit Angkor Thom and Bayon, where you'll pass through the walled enclosure and over the moat to admire the elaborate stone carvings of people and mythological creatures. Next, see the Elephant Terrace and the Terrace of the Leper King, which staged important public events and ceremonies. Angkor Wat has become a symbol of Cambodia, even appearing on its national flag.
- Visit an artisan workshop and see how local art is made.
- Participate in a Khmer cooking class

#### Day 6: Siem Reap

- Visit Angkor Wat.
- Visit Angkor Thom: Bayon Temple; Elephant Terrace; Terrace of the Leper King.
- Enjoy a cultural dance show.
- Visit TaProhm Temple

#### Day 7: Siem Reap

- Visit the Cambodian Landmine Museum.
- Learn about family-focused economic efforts at a local NGO.
- Take an excursion to Tonlé Sap Lake.

#### Day 8: Siem Reap | Bangkok

- Travel to Bangkok. From gleaming silver skyscrapers to ancient jewel-box temples and serene Buddhist monasteries, Thailand seems resolved to straddle two millennia. Ancient traditions govern the behaviour of a modern people, and the timeless merges with the contemporary. Experience this enduring and spirited culture in Bangkok. Boat along the Chao Phraya River and Thonburi klongs (canals), where ornate homes and gilded temples once earned Bangkok the name "The Venice of the East." Visit the Grand Palace, an enormous royal compound bordered by high walls built to separate kings from commoners. Gaze upward at the golden spires of this architectural masterpiece, and enter the Royal Chapel (Wat Phra Kaew) that houses the most sacred Emerald Buddha.

#### Day 9: Bangkok

- Take an expert-led tour of Bangkok.
- Visit the Grand Palace and the Temple of the Emerald Buddha.
- Take a boat tour of the Chao Phraya River and Thonburi klongs.
- Visit Wat Pho (Temple of the Reclining Buddha), which is covered entirely in precious gold.
- Explore the Museum of Siam, an interactive museum that depicts Thai history and culture.
- Enjoy an authentic Thai dinner and classical dance show.

#### Day 10: Ayutthaya | Bangkok

- Take an excursion to Ayutthaya.
- Enjoy free time in Bangkok or
- Participate in an organic farm experience with dinner

#### Day 11: Depart for home
