

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Montréal

- Travel to Montréal, the largest city in Québec. Predominantly French-speaking, it's set on an island in the Saint Lawrence River and named after Mt. Royal, the triple-peaked hill at its heart. Its 19 boroughs, many of which were once independent cities, include neighbourhoods from cobblestoned, French colonial Vieux-Montréal—with imposing Notre-Dame Basilica at its centre—to industrial Sud-Ouest and artist-friendly Plateau.
- Take a tour of Montréal: streets of Old Montreal; Old Port; Jacques Cartier Square; Underground City; Chinatown.
- Enjoy an evening activity.

Day 2: Montréal

 Take an expertly guided tour of Montréal: Notre Dame Basilica; Mount Royal Park; St. Joseph's Oratory; City Hall; Montreal Harbour; McGill University; Place des Arts; Place Ville Marie.

Day 3: Montréal | Québec City

- Visit the Olympic Tower funicular.
- Travel to Québec City, a historic locale dating back to 1608. To this day, it retains its fortified colonial core, Vieux-Québec and Place Royale, with narrow streets, stone buildings and a European feel. This area is where you'll find the famous, towering Château Frontenac Hotel and imposing Citadelle of Québec. The Petit Champlain district's cobblestone streets are lined with bistros and boutiques.
- Enjoy an expertly guided sightseeing tour of Québec City: Streets of the Old City; Petit Champlain area; Chateau Frontenac; Place Royale; National Assembly; Grande Allée; Upper Town.

Day 4: Québec City | Beaupré Coast

- Visit the Plains of Abraham and enjoy a military workshop.
- Enjoy free time for lunch.
- Take a tour of the Beaupré Coast.
- Visit the Sainte-Anne de Beaupré Basilica.
- Visit Montmorency Falls.
- Enjoy dinner and a sugar shack experience.
