THE SHARED TRAIL

6 days | Vancouver and Keremeos (Summer only)

Travel to Camp Acxwulaxw to participate in the Shared Trail Program which focuses on perspectives in reconciliation between Indigenous Nations and the Nation State of Canada through the context of the Syilx Nation. Participate in immersive workshops and guided reflection sessions to learn about Syilx history, culture, worldview, and contemporary perspectives. Afterwards, travel back to the City of Vancouver, located on the traditional, ancestral, and unceded territory of the Musqueam, Squamish, and Tsleil-Waututh Nations—together forming part of the Coast Salish peoples. Spend time learning about Coast Salish history and culture.



What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Arrive in Vancouver

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Vancouver and breathe in the air of Canada's west coast.
- Take an expertly guided tour of the city. Surrounded by mountains, the city of Vancouver is a hub of culture, history, and outdoor living.
- Take an expertly guided tour of Stanley Park including the renowned Stanley Park Totem Poles where you will hear the stories of the totem poles and the artists who carved them.

Day 2: Vancouver | Keremeos

- Travel to Keremeos, a village in the sunny Similkameen Valley. The name originates from the Similkameen dialect of the Okanagan word "Keremeyus" meaning "creek which cuts its way through the flats" and refers to the Keremeos Creek that runs by the village. While you enjoy the stunning views, learn more about the rich history of the region and the Syilx people—the first inhabitants of the Okanagan region.
- At Camp Acxwulaxw, start your first day of three days participating in the Shared Trail Program, which focuses on perspectives in reconciliation between Indigenous Nations and the Nation State of Canada through the context of the Syilx Nation. While you're here, experience Syilx history, culture, worldview, and contemporary perspectives.
- Enjoy a provided lunch

Day 3: Keremeos

- Day two of the Shared Trail Program. Participate in immersive activities throughout the day and enjoy a provided lunch with your group.

Day 4: Keremeos | Vancouver

- Day three of the Shared Trail Program. Participate in immersive activities throughout the day and enjoy a provided lunch with your group.
- Return to Vancouver.
- Enjoy some free time at Granville Island.

Day 5: Vancouver

- Visit the Bill Reid Gallery—the only public gallery in Canada devoted to contemporary Indigenous Art of the Northwest Coast. Through his art, Bill Reid continues to inspire emerging and established contemporary Indigenous artists of the Northwest Coast. His legacies include infusing the art traditions of the Haida with modern forms of expression, influencing the next generation of artists, and building lasting bridges between First Nations and other peoples.
- Participate in a workshop at the gallery.

- Enjoy the FlyOver Canada ride.
