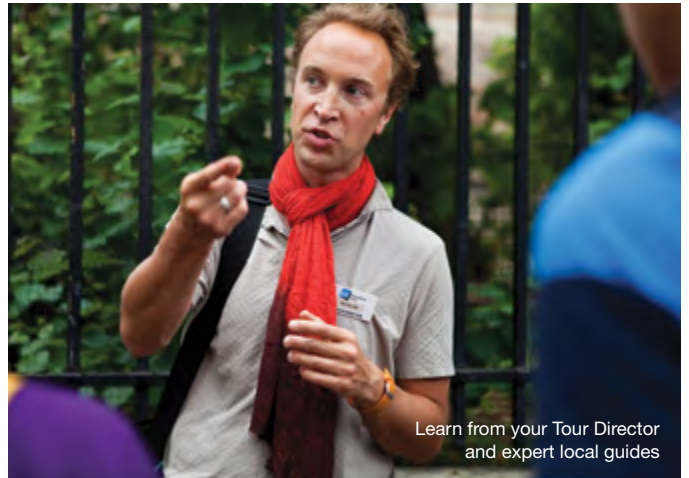

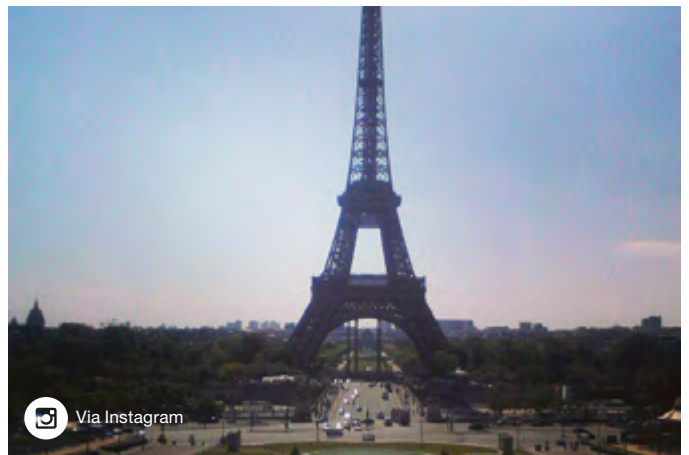

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to France

Day 2: Paris

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Paris, the City of Light.
- Take a walking tour of Paris: Île de la Cité.
- Visit the Notre Dame Cathedral to admire its sculptured façade, stained-glass rose windows, and seemingly weightless vaulted ceilings.

Day 3: Paris

- During your expertly guided tour of Paris, you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power.
- Visit the Musée d'Orsay.

Day 4: Paris

- Visit the Louvre and explore art from around the world as you wander from wing to wing of one of Paris's biggest attractions and the most visited museum in the world. Built to defend the city in the 13th century, today the Louvre safeguards collections that span continents and the ages. Enter by I.M. Pei's glass pyramid, considered a controversial addition by many resident Parisians. Inside, discover Greek, Roman, and Asian antiquities, as well as precious objects from the Middle Ages. These massive halls are home to over 35,000 objects; among them is Leonardo da Vinci's masterpiece, the *Mona Lisa*. Be sure to get an up-close look at her beguiling smile.
- Strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower.
- Time to see more of Paris or
 - ✦ participate in an art activity (drawing or painting).
- Enjoy an authentic steak frites dinner.

Day 5: Paris

- Full day to see more of Paris or
 - ✦ visit Chartres and the Loire Valley: Chartres Cathedral; Chenonceau.

Day 6: Paris | Versailles

- Travel to Versailles.
- Nobody does decadence like Louis XIV, and there's no better testament to this than Versailles—which you'll experience during your expertly guided tour. Under the direction of the Sun King, the château that began as a modest hunting lodge exploded into one of the largest palaces on earth. On your excursion to this lavish estate, explore the state apartments of the king and queen and the magnificent Hall of Mirrors. Walk through the meticulously landscaped gardens and marvel at dozens of ornate fountains. Discover why Versailles was more than just a vacation home: Louis XIV hosted his royal court here to reign in their power and prevent their political rise.

Day 7: Paris

- Enjoy a free morning to explore on your own or
 - ✦ visit Monet's Giverny.
- Enjoy free time at the Marché des Enfants Rouges, the oldest covered market in Paris.

Day 8: Depart for home

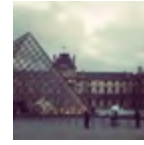
Day 8: Paris | London

Day 9: London
