




What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Montréal | Québec City

- Arrive in Montréal and meet your Tour Director
- Travel to Québec City, a historic locale that dates to 1608, it retains its fortified colonial core, Vieux-Québec and Place Royale, with narrow streets, stone buildings and a European feel. This area is site of the famous, towering Château Frontenac Hotel and imposing Citadelle of Québec. The Petit Champlain district's cobblestone streets are lined with bistros and boutiques.
- Enjoy free time at Carnaval with an Effigy Pass.

Day 2: Québec City

- Take an expertly guided tour of Québec City: Streets of the Old City; Petit Champlain area; Chateau Frontenac; Place Royale; National Assembly; Grande Allée, Upper town.
- Enjoy free time for lunch.
- Visit the Old Québec Museum or
- enjoy a Winter Experience at Huron-Wendat Village.

Day 3: Québec City

Day 4: Québec City | Montréal

- Travel to Montréal, Montréal is the largest city in Québec. Predominantly French-speaking, it's set on an island in the Saint Lawrence River and named after Mt. Royal, the triplepeaked hill at its heart. Its 19 boroughs, many of which were once independent cities, include neighbourhoods from cobblestoned, French colonial Vieux-Montréal—with imposing Notre-Dame Basilica at its centre—to industrial Sud-Ouest and artist-friendly Plateau.
- Enjoy free time for lunch.
- Visit the Montréal Planetarium.
- Take a guided tour of Old Montréal: Streets of Old Montréal; Old Port; Jacques Cartier Square; Underground City; Chinatown.
- Participate in an evening activity.

Day 5: Montréal

- Take a tour of Montréal: Mount Royal Park;
 Jacques Cartier Square; St. Joseph's Oratory;
 City Hall; Montreal Harbor; McGill University;
 Place des Arts; Place Ville Marie.
- Visit the Notre-Dame Basilica.
- Visit the Archaeology Museum.
- Enjoy an Old Montréal Dinner experience.
- Participate in an evening activity.

Day 6: Depart for home

- Enjoy free time in Montréal before travelling home.
